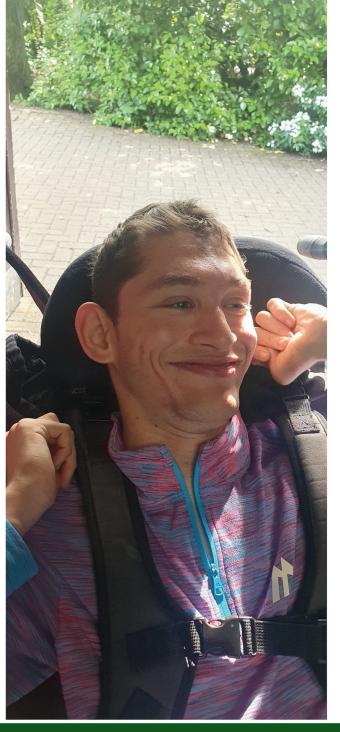

CHOCKS AWAY

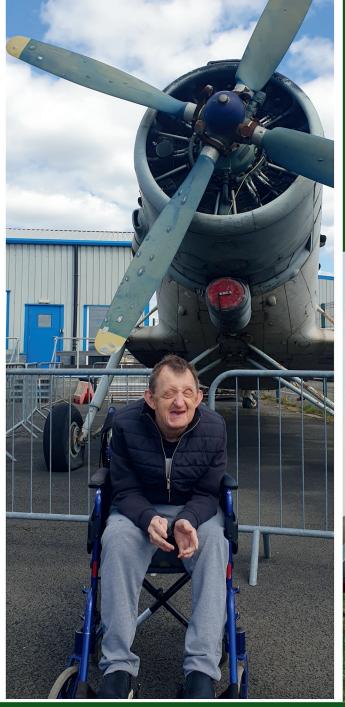

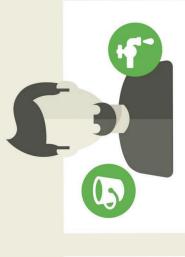
