Many more wishes are still waiting to be granted, so we sincerely appreciate your continued support. Your contributions will help provide essential funding for this important initiative.



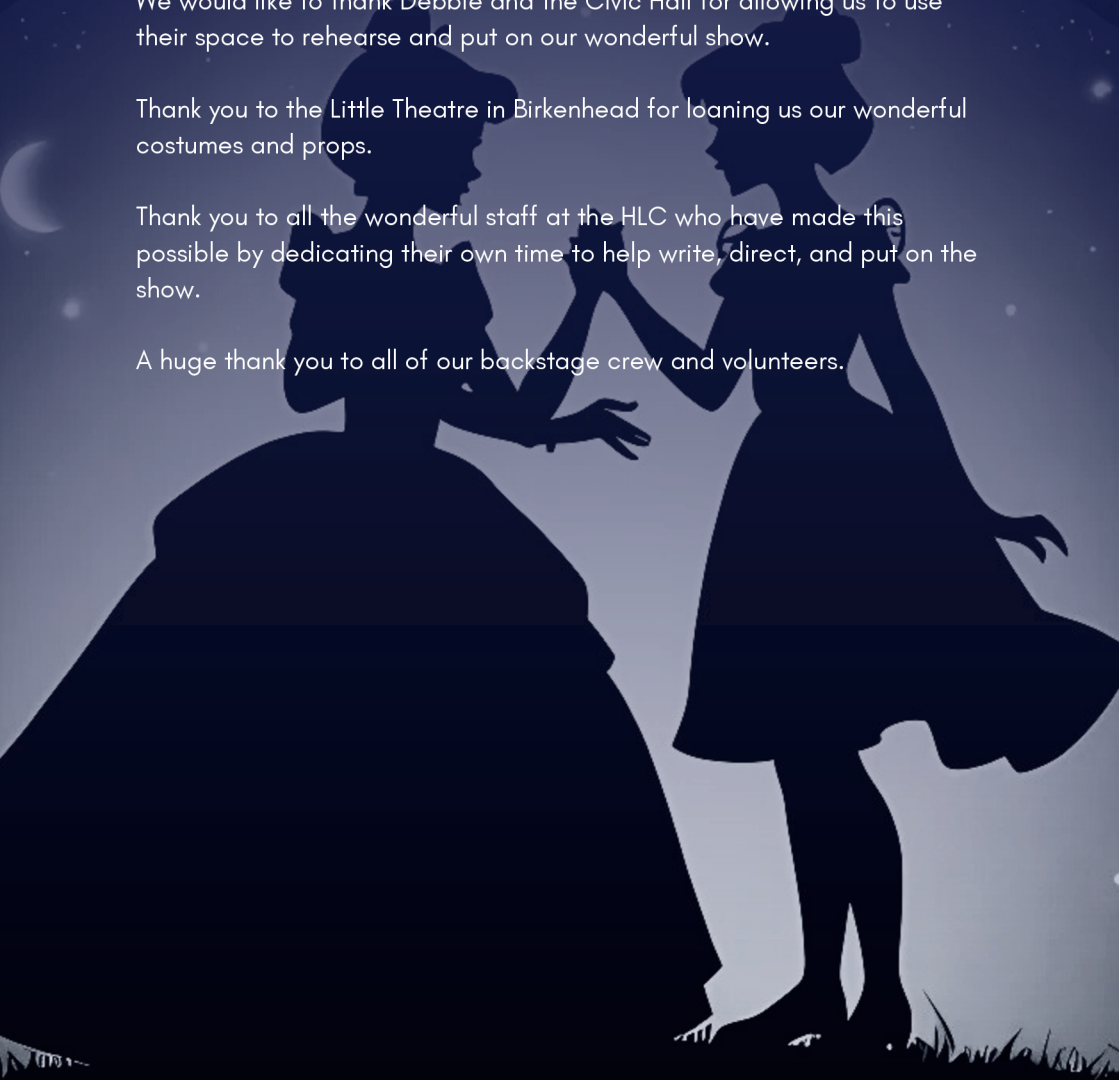
